## **A few things you may have noticed:**

- The door Jesus is knocking at has no handle – he must be invited into our hearts.
- The door is overgrown with plants and looks like it hasn't been opened in a while – Jesus is still waiting, always there when we need him.
- Jesus is carrying a lantern (the light of conscience), has a halo (the light of salvation) and behind him the sun is rising.  
(a new spiritual dawn)



**Jesus is calling us to be a visible and positive influence for others.**

He calls us to reflect God's love, God's truth and God's hope in a dark world through good deeds and actions.

**We are asked to light the path for others so they too can find God.**



Pope Leo reminds us that

“each of us can be a little light”.

**Even a small light provides some guidance. A small action will always provide hope to someone else.**
